### Nationally Consistent Collection of Data 2018 Information for Parents and Carers

The Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disabilities (the national data collection) is an

annual collection that counts the number of school students with a disability and the level of reasonable educational adjustment they are provided with.

## What Is The Benefit For My Child?

This information will help teachers, principals, education authorities and families to better support students with a disability to fully partcipate in school on the same basis as students without a disability.

## What Information Will Be Collected?

Every year your child's school will collect the following information for each student with a disability:

- . the student's level of education (ie primary or secondary)
- . the student's level of adjustment
- . the student's broad type of disability.

The information collected by schools will be provided to all governments to inform policy and program improvement for students with a disability.

## How Will My Child's Privacy Be Protected?

Protecting the privacy and confidentiality of all students and their families is essential. Personal details such as student names or other identifying information will be not be provided to local or federal education and authorities.
