We know this means that some parents may need to collect their children from multiple cinemas; however, we believe this is the safest method. The main priority at the end of the night is the safety of the students. Please keep in mind that students will be tired and staff will have been on duty for close to 14 hours.

School Crossings

"The School Crossing Supervisor program is a state-wide program that contributes to the safety of infants and primary school students. School crossing supervisors help students use the crossings on roads adjacent to or nearby schools. School crossing supervisors are provided where transport authority guidelines and criteria are met.

School crossing supervisors are provided to increase mobility and safety around schools by enhancing the performance of pedestrian traffic facilities. School crossing supervisors provide additional measures for the safe and efficient movement of primary and infant schoolchildren."

The crossing supervisors are the responsibility of NSW Transport - Roads and Maritime(RMS)

On occasion the RMS will contact the school to advise of crossing supervisor absences. School staff voluntarilly provide the role of crossing supervisor to ensure the safety of Rosemeadow stdents and the community. If there are no crossing supervisors on duty please take your child's hand and supervise them to cross the road safely. You will be teaching them valuable life skills.
